1. What is the role of a Table Host?

Table Hosts play an essential role in the Celebrate Life event. You are encouraged to invite guests who may support MCWC's mission financially. Before the event, please stay in touch with your guests and share any updates. On the night of the event, welcome them, answer basic questions, and distribute and collect donation envelopes. Training and support will be provided.

2. How many guests are seated at each table?

Each table seats **10 guests**.

6. Will I be collecting money?

Donation envelopes will be provided at each table. Detailed instructions will be shared with Table Hosts as the event approaches. Inviting guests to support MCWC is an important part of hosting.

7. Why do we ask guests to donate? Doesn't the reservation or Table Host fee cover costs?

Reservation and table fees only cover event expenses such as the venue, meals, and speaker fees. As MCWC's largest annual fundraiser, guest donations are vital to supporting our mission.

8. What if I don't fill my table?

Please make every effort to fill your table. If you receive cancellations, consider inviting additional friends or contacts. As the event approaches, MCWC may fill any open seats at your table with guests who purchased individual reservations, pending your approval, to ensure all seating is fully utilized.

9. If guests are added to my table, will I be reimbursed?

Reimbursement is not provided. Tables are purchased as donations at a discounted rate. Partial reimbursement would require canceling the table purchase and repurchasing seats at the higher individual rate.

10. Who do I contact with questions?

11. Will there be a cash bar?

No. A cash bar will not be available.

12. Can I bring my children?

Due to limited seating and the fundraising focus of the event, attendance is limited to adults.
